


#### **Connect Power Cord**




Press the POWER button on the remote control to turn on the TV






# Insert the TV into the base and securely attach. Install the batteries in the Remote Control



To operate this TV using the remote control provided by your Cable / Satellite provider, follow the programming instructions included with the providers' remote control and input the following codes when prompted;

- -For Comcast or DirecTV remote controls, input the code- 10030.
- -For AT&T (U-verse) remote Controls, input the code-1043.
- -For RCA Universal Remote Controls, input the code- 0030.
- -For Dish Network remote controls, input the code- 506.
