



## **USE OF THE REMOTE CONTROL**

#### BATTERIES

- Remove the cover on the rear of the Remote Control and insert two AAA Batteries
- Make sure the +(positive) and -(negative) ends of the batteries are facing the correct direction as shown inside the remote control. Close the rear battery cover
- When using the Remote Control, point the Remote directly at the IR Receiving Lens (6) on the front panel of the DVD player. Make sure there are no objects obstructing the path from the Remote Control and the IR Receiving Lens (6) on the front panel.
- The Remote Control will only operate from a maximum distance of 5-30 Feet from the Player. If the Remote stops functioning from your normal distance, replace both batteries in the Remote.
- The Battery Compartment should be checked on a regular schedule to confirm there is no battery leakage which can damage the Remote. Replace any leaking batteries immediately

#### REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

- · POWER: Turn the DVD Player ON or OFF (Standby)
- · OPEN/CLOSE: Open or Close the Disc Tray (2)
- NUMBERS (0-9): Used for entering direct numbers of DVD Chapters and CD song tracks
- · VOL- / VOL+: Increase or decrease the audio volume
- SETUP: Press to display the Setup Menu to select different functions and operating preferences
- ENTER: Press to confirm your selection
- NAVIGATION ARROWS: Press to move back to the previous menu selection or to navigate Up, Down, Left, or Right on the on-screen display
- MENU: Press to display the Main Menu for playing a DVD
- OSD (On-Screen Display): Press OSD repeatedly to cycle through the various types of disc information. Each Press; (1) Current Title/Chapter, (2) Audio & Subtitle, (3) Chapter Time Elapsed & Remaining, (4) Title Time Elapsed & Remaining, (5) OFF
- ZOOM: Press ZOOM repeatedly (for ZOOM enabled DVDs only) to select from the following ZOOM modes; (1) 2x ZOOM, (2) 3x ZOOM, (3) 4x ZOOM, (4) 1/2x ZOOM, (5) 1/3x ZOOM, (6) 1/4x ZOOM, (7) ZOOM OFF
- · PLAY / PAUSE: Press to start or Pause DVD/CD playback
- · STOP: The STOP button has two functions:
  - Press STOP 1x to stop DVD/CD playback. Press PLAY / PAUSE to resume playback from the location where playback was stopped
  - Pressing STOP 2x will stop DVD/CD playback and clear the stop point location. Press PLAY / PAUSE to start playback from the beginning of the disc.
- PLAY / PAUSE: Press to start or pause DVD/CD playback
- NEXT / PREVIOUS: Press to skip to the Next or Previous Chapter or Track on the disc
- FAST FWD / FAST REV: Press during playback to fast forward or reverse to a specific part of the disc. Press PLAY / PAUSE to resume normal speed playback.

### Play a DVD

Turn on the TV set and select A/V mode.

1. Press the **POWER** button on the front panel. If there is a DVD in the tray, "DISC LOADING" will appear.

**NOTE**: If there is no disc in the player, "NO DISC" will appear.

- 2. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button and the disc tray will open.
- 3. Place a DVD on the disc tray. **NOTE**: Make sure the desired screen format (i.e. Widescreen) is facedown.
- 4. Press **OPEN/CLOSE** to close the tray. The disc type (DVD, MP3, JPEG) will appear in the upper left hand corner. NOTE: It is possible to damage a disc if not placed correctly on the guides in the disc tray. This can also cause the DVD player to malfunction. Only use a 5" DVD or CD with this DVD player. Never move the DVD player during playback. To avoid damaging the DVD player, only use the **OPEN/CLOSE** button on the DVD player or Remote Control to open and close the disc tray.
- **5**. Press the **PREV** or **NEXT** buttons to play the previous or next track.
- Press the FWD or REV buttons on the remote to fast forward or reverse.
   NOTE: The speed will change each time the button is pressed. Press the PLAY/PAUSE button to resume normal playback.

## **Stop Playback**

1. Press the STOP button to stop the disc. With some formats, like DVD, this player will resume play exactly where STOP was pressed.

NOTE: The LAST MEMORY setting in the DISPLAY SETUP MENU must be set to ON for this function to work.

2. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to resume playback from where the disc was stopped.

**NOTE**: If you press **STOP** 2x the DVD player will stop and playback will restart from the beginning of the disc.

## On Screen Display (OSD)

While a disc is playing the status of various functions can be checked by pressing the **OSD** button.

- 1. Press **OSD** 1x to display the title, chapter, and time played
- 2. Press OSD 2x to display the audio and subtitle information
- 3. Press **OSD** 3x to display the total elapsed time for the current chapter
- **4**. Press **OSD** 4x to display the total elapsed time for the current title
- **5**. Press **OSD** 5x and the display will turn OFF.

### **Subtitles**

This DVD player can display subtitles in 6 different languages (English, Spanish, French, German, Italian, & Chinese).

**NOTE**: The DVD must be multi-subtitle enabled for this function to work.

- 1. Press the **SUBTITLE** button and the Subtitle Menu will appear. Select the desired lange by pressing the **SUBTITLE** button until your preference is shown.
- 2. To turn subtitles OFF, press the **SUBTITLE** button until the subtitles disappear.

### **DVD/USB**

This DVD player supports playback of MP3 & WMA audio files, AVI Video files and JPEG photos from a USB drive.

Press the **DVD/USB** button on the remote control to switch between DVD & USB modes.

Use the Navigation Buttons on the remote control to highlight the file you wish to view and press the **ENTER** button to start playback.

### Search

- 1. Press the **SEARCH** button to display the search menu on the TV screen.
- Use the Navigation buttons to select a desired Title/Chapter. A Title/Chapter can also be chosen by entering the Title or Chapter number with the NUMBER buttons.
- 3. Press the **ENTER** button to start playback from the selected Title or Chapter.

NOTE: Some discs will not respond to this function. If different instructions appear on your DVD follow those instructions. Title and Chapter selection procedures may vary depending on the content of a particular DVD.

### **A-B** Repeat

This DVD player can repeat a specific set of points on a DVD in a continuous loop.

- Press A-B 1x to set a starting point.
  Press A-B 2x to set the ending point.
- The selected starting and ending points will repeat in a continuous loop.
- **3**. Press **A-B** 3x to stop the loop and return to normal playback.

### Volume

Use the volume controls on your TV remote to adjust the volume level coming from your TV speakers.

### Zoom

This DVD player has the ability to enlarge or decrease the picture size during DVD playback by pressing the **ZOOM** button.

Each time the **ZOOM** button is pressed the size of the image on the TV will either increase or decrease as follows:

- Press ZOOM 1x image increased by 2x
- Press **ZOOM** 2x image increased by 3x
- Press ZOOM 3x image increased by 4x
- Press **ZOOM** 4x image decreased by 2x
- Press **ZOOM** 5x image decreased by 3x
- Press **ZOOM** 6x image decreased by 4x
- Press ZOOM 7x image will return to the normal size.

**NOTE:** The DVD disc must be ZOOM enabled

## **Repeat Play**

This DVD player allows repeated playback of specific Titles, Chapters, & CD Tracks by pressing the **REPEAT** button

- **1**. Begin playing the desired Title, Track, or Chapter.
- 2 Press the REPEAT button

NOTE: The repeat mode changes each time the REPEAT button is pressed as follows:


- Press REPEAT 1x= Repeat Chapter / Track
- Press **REPEAT** 2x= Repeat Title
- Press REPEAT 3x= Repeat Entire Disc
- Press REPEAT 4x= Repeat OFF (return to normal playback)

### **DVD** Menu Setup

- 1. Press the **SETUP** button on the remote and the Setup menu will appear.
- 2. Use the **Up** or **Down** Navigation buttons to highlight the desired menu.
- 3. Press the **ENTER** button to confirm the highlighted selection and enter the desired submenu.
- 4. Use the **Up** & **Down** Navigation buttons to highlight the desired setting option then press **ENTER** to confirm.

### Language

This option is used to choose the Language for the OSD, Subtitles, DVD Audio, & Setup Menus.



### **OSD LANGUAGE:**

There are 3 languages to choose from: English, French, Spanish.

### SUBTITLE:

There are 3 options to choose from: English, French, Spanish.

#### AUDIO:


There are 3 options to choose from: English, French, Spanish.

### **DVD SETUP MENU:**

There are 3 options to choose from: English, French, Spanish.

### **Display**

This option is used to choose various settings related to Video.



#### ASPECT RATIO:

There are two kinds of Aspect Ratios for TVs, 4:3 & 16:9 which can be selected according to the disc format & TV Type.

16:9: Use this setting if you are using a 16:9 format Widescreen TV.

4:3 LB: Will keep the image in the same format according to the content on the DVD. Widescreen DVDs will be shown in a letterbox format

**4:3 PS**: Will automatically edit and show a Widescreen or other format video as a Full screen image.


#### TV TYPE:

This unit is specifically made for Region 1 discs and will operate on the NTSC system.

#### VIDEO OUT:

This unit supports CVBS video (red/white/yellow jacks) outputs.

#### SYSTEM SETUP



#### ANGLE MARK:

When this setting is turned ON a small Camera icon will appear on the TV to indicate multiple camera angles can be chosen.

**NOTE**: The DVD must be multi-angle enabled for this function to work.

#### SCREEN SAVER:

When this setting is turned ON a screen saver will appear after a long period of no activity. To return to normal operation simply press a button on the remote.


#### LAST MEMORY:

When this setting is turned ON the DVD player will remember the point where playback was stopped so playback can resume from that point the next time the PLAY/PAUSE button is pressed.

**NOTE**: If this setting is turned OFF the DVD will always start from the beginning of the disc after playback is stopped.

### **Speaker**

This option (3D / EQ) is used to choose from various audio electronic presets.



### **Parental Control**

This menu allows you to restrict viewing of certain movie ratings.



### Change:

To make any changes to the Parental Controls a Password must first be entered.

**NOTE**: The first time this menu is selected enter the Default Password "0000"

Once the Password is confirmed you will be asked to enter a new password. To set a new password use the **NUMBER** buttons to enter a new 4-digit password, or you can keep the Default Password and enter "0000".

### Rating Level:

To change the acceptable rating level for playback, use the LEFT & RIGHT Navigation buttons to highlight the rating boxes. Press ENTER to select the maximum accepted rating.

**NOTE**: If you do not wish to use the Parental Control feature simply choose the Rating Level box named **OFF**.

### Default Reset:

If you want to reset the DVD player to the factory default settings highlight "Default Reset" and press ENTER.

**NOTE**: Any settings you have changed previously will need to be changed again.



## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Reason	Solution
Power is connected but the player does not work.	Plug is not inserted correctly into the wall outlet.	Reinsert the power cord into the wall outlet or try a different wall outlet.
Disc is inserted in the player but there is nothing displayed on the TV screen.	Disc is inserted upside-down; disc is dirty, scratched, or cracked.	Correctly insert the disc into the player; repair or clean the disc and wait until the disc has completely dried (one-hour) before re-inserting into the player.
No sound	Audio cables are not properly connected.	Make sure the RED & WHITE cables are properly connected on both the DVD player and TV.
No Picture	Video Cable is not properly connected; TV is not on the correct INPUT	Make sure the YELLOW cable is properly connected on both the DVD player and TV. Adjust the TV to the correct INPUT/SOURCE (refer to TV owners manual)
The Remote Control doesn't work	Batteries no longer work; remote is not pointed directly at the remote sensor.	Change the batteries. Move closer to the DVD player and point the remote directly at the front. Make sure there is no object between the remote and the IR receiver on the player.
During playback, the image freezes, skips, or the sound is distorted.	The disc is in poor condition.	Repair or clean the disc and wait until the disc has completely dried (one-hour) before re-inserting into the player.
