




Before you begin: Open, identify and count all parts prior to assembly. Lay out parts on a flat and non-abrasive surface. You will need the parts identified on page 5 and 6 of this instruction manual.

NOTE: IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO USE GLUE WITH DOWELS. EXCESS GLUE CAN BE WIPED OFF WITH DAMP CLOTH.


Insert the Dowel at least half way by tapping lightly with a rubber mallet, IF NECESSARY.







CAM LOCK SYSTEM OPERATION




HOW THE KNOCK DOWN (KD) ASSEMBLY SYSTEM WORKS

- 1. Screw the Cam Bolt into the threaded inserts on the panel. Connect both panels together; making sure Cam Bolt goes into the pre-drilled hole on the end of panel for Cam Lock.
- 2. Insert the Cam Lock into the pre-drilled large hole on the panel. Make sure the arrow on the face of Cam Lock faces out and points towards Cam Bolt.
- 3. Take a Phillips screwdriver and rotate the Cam Lock clockwise to lock the Cam Bolt in place.
- 4. Plug the Cam Lock Cover into the cross slot of the Cam Lock to conceal the Cam.




- 1. Unpack the unit and confirm that you have all the hardware and required parts. Assemble the unit on a carpeted floor or the empty carton to avoid any scratching.
- 2. Securely screw the Cam Bolts (2) into the designated small holes on the Top Panel (A), Bottom Panel (B) and Side Panels (C and E) using a Phillips screwdriver.




3. Attach the Bottom Back Stretcher (I) to the Bottom Panel (B) with two 30 mm Wood Dowels (3) and three Cam Locks (1).




4. Attach the Partition Panels (D and F) to the Bottom Panel (B) with four 30 mm Wood Dowels (3) and four 50 mm Screws (7) as shown.




- 5. Attach the Left Side Panel (C) to the Bottom Panel (B) and Bottom Back Stretcher (I) with three 30 mm Wood Dowels (3) and three Cam Locks (1).
- 6. Repeat the same procedure to attach the Right Side Panel (E) at the opposite end.




7. Attach the Bottom Front Stretcher (H) to the Bottom Panel (B) with two 30 mm Wood Dowels (3) and three Cam Locks (1) as shown.




8. Fasten the Bottom Front Stretcher (H) to the Side Panels (C and E) with four 50 mm Screws (7).




9. Attach the Bottom Front Molding (G) to the Bottom Front Stretcher (H) with four 20 mm Wood Dowels (4) and eight 25 mm Screws (6).




10. Using the pilot holes as a guide, fasten two Triangle Metal Plates (13) at the bottom joints between Side Panels (C and E) and Bottom Front Stretcher (H) with eight 15 mm Flat Head Screws (5).




11. Screw two Floor Levelers (14) into the installed Triangle Metal Plates (13).



12. Attach the Top Panel (A) to the vertical panels (C, D, E and F) with eight 30 mm Wood Dowels (3) and eight Cam Locks (1).




- 13. Now, go back and securely tighten all the Cam Locks and the Screws. Make sure that all the parts are tight and there are no gaps between the parts. This will help keep the unit square.
- 14. Unfold the Back Panel (J) and align the pre-drilled holes against the upper long edge with the pilot holes on the back stretcher of the Top Panel (A). Attach the Back Panel (J) in place using the provided Washer Head Screws (8).



15. Stand the unit upright.

16. Insert the Shelf Pins (10) into the desired holes in the sides of the compartments. Make sure you place the four Shelf Pins in the same level so the shelf is not tilted. Tilt and rest the Adjustable Shelves (L and M) onto the Shelf Pins (10) with the end notches of the Shelf fit onto the Shelf Pins properly.





17. Attach one Knob (11) to the front side of each Door (K) with the provided Knob Bolt (12).

How to adjust the European adjustable hinges on doors


Shipping may cause doors to go out of alignment. If you find that the doors need to be adjusted slightly, turn the appropriate screw, as illustrated below:

- 1 TO ADJUST DOOR FORWARD OR BACKWARD.
- 2 TO ADJUST DOOR TO RIGHT OR TO LEFT.
- 3 TO ADJUST DOOR UP OR DOWN.






- 18. Pick up one Door (K) and attach the extended Hinge Arms to the Hinge Bases installed on Left Side Panel (C). Loosen the bolt on the back of Hinge Base for an easy fit. Align and insert the "U" slot on Hinge Arm under the bolt head on the back of Hinge Base. Make sure that both door hinges engage and function properly. Tighten the bolt on the Hinge Base to lock the hinges in place.
- 19. Repeat the same procedure to attach the other Door (K) to the Right Side Panel (E).
- 20. Open and close the doors to make sure they are aligned and shut correctly. If necessary, adjust the screws for a good fit. Refer to the hinge sticker on the door for adjustment.




- 21. Plug the Cam Lock Covers (9) onto the visible Cams Locks to conceal the Cams.
- 22. Peel off the Rubber Bumpers (15) from the bumper card and stick them at the outer corners of the Doors (K) where they come in contact with the Partition Panels (D and F).



NOTE: You must install the strip stopper to prevent the TV from tipping when placing your flat panel television directly on the console.

- 23. Remove the paper backing from the Stop Rail (N), then properly align the Stop Rail with the top edge of the stopper template on the Top Panel (A). Press down on the Stop Rail to help adhesion.
- 24. Carefully remove the stopper template from the Top Panel (A).



Tools required: Phillips screwdriver, Power Drill, 3/8" Drill Bit and Rubber Mallet.

25. Ask for assistance to position the assembled unit at the desired location against a wall. If necessary, adjust the installed Floor Levelers (14) at the bottom of the mantel to level the unit. Now, follow the instructions printed on the plastic bag containing the Tipping Restraint Hardware to attach the tip-over restraints to the unit and the wall.
